

### **The Freedom Prize**

The **Freedom Prize** is awarded to a person or an organisation committed to a fight for freedom. He/she is nominated, selected and elected by young people aged 15 to 25, in Normandy, in other regions of France and throughout the world.

When responding to the call for proposals "Our Freedom Prize 2020", your group should choose, present and defend a recent fight for freedom as well as the person or organisation that is leading it, by completing this form.

An **international panel of judges** will meet on 14th and 15th February 2020 to examine all the fights proposed and select three finalists. An **online vote** open from 9th March to 12th April 2020 will decide between them and determine the winner of the second **Freedom Prize.** 

### The call for proposals "Our Freedom Prize 2020"

To respond to the call for proposals "Our Freedom Prize 2020", you will need to complete this form. Its purpose is to guide your group's thinking on the fight for freedom you wish to defend and to provide all the necessary information for the Freedom Prize international judges to understand your nomination. It consists of 3 parts:

#### 1. Our group

The information provided is necessary for the organizers to follow up your submission effectively.

### 2. Our Freedom Prize 2020

The questions are designed to give a complete and reasoned presentation of the chosen person or organisation and their fight for freedom.

### 3. Panel factsheet

This is a compulsory form, summarizing the various points discussed in your project. This is the first document sent to the members of the Freedom Prize panel of judges. The complete file will be consulted only if the judges request it.



### **Promotion**

The organizers and partners of the Freedom Prize will select different international groups, French groups (not including Normandy) and groups from Normandy for the quality of their submissions. <u>Trips, stays and invitations to the award ceremony will be awarded.</u>

Any incomplete form or one that does not comply with these conditions will not be taken into account.

The signed version of this digital form must be returned by email to <u>prixliberte@normandie.fr</u>, <u>by 17th</u> <u>January 2020 at the latest</u>. Any form sent after this date will not be taken into account.

Your file must be entitled with the name of the organization or surname of the person you are nominating for the 2020 Freedom Prize (followed by the first name if it is a person), then the name of your institution/organization (or a surname from the group if you are participating on your own initiative).
